## Caladium Care Guide

### Welcome Home!

Thank you for giving one of our hand-grown caladiums a forever home. With a little care, your plant will reward you with beautiful foliage all season long.

■ ■ Light	Bright, indirect light. Morning sun is wonderful. Protect from hot afternoon sun.
■ Water	Keep soil evenly moist but never soggy. Water when the top inch begins to dry.
■ Soil	Use a rich, well-draining potting mix with perlite and compost or worm castings.
■ Temperature	Ideal: 65°F–85°F. Protect from temperatures below 60°F.
■ Feeding	Feed every 4–6 weeks during the growing season with a balanced liquid fertilizer at half strength.
■ Common Issues	Yellow leaves: overwatering. Brown edges: too much sun or underwatering. Drooping: thirsty.
* ■ Winter Dormancy	As leaves die back, reduce watering. Store tubers dry at 60–70°F. Replant in spring.
